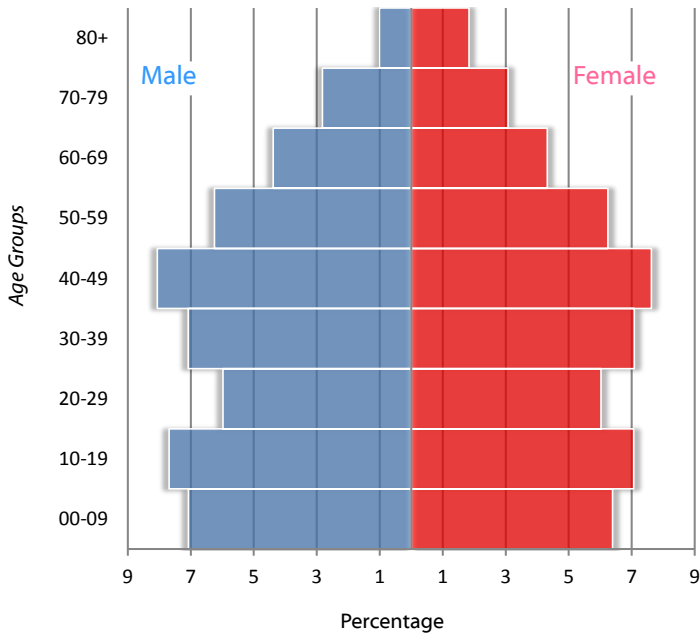

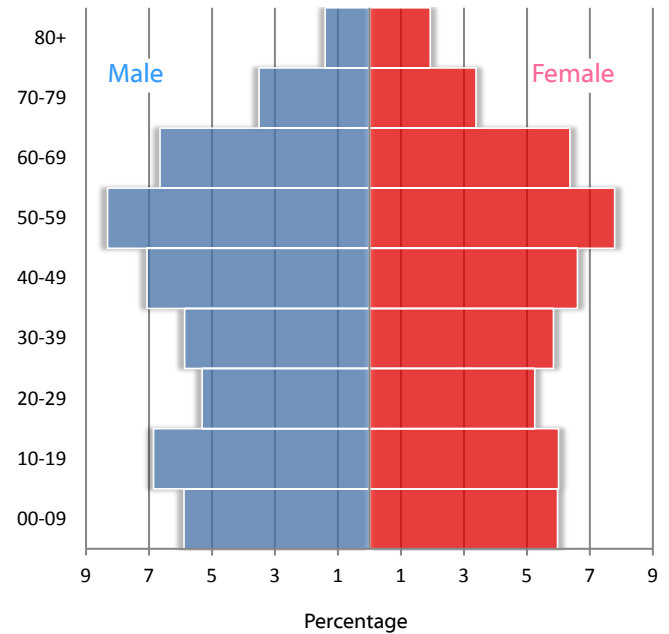

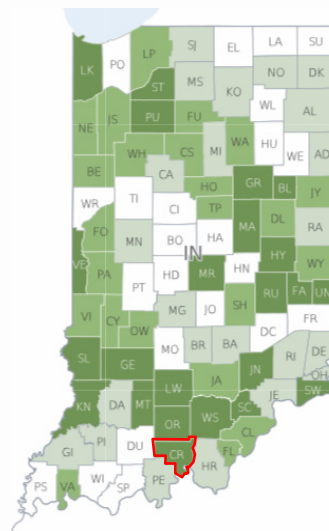

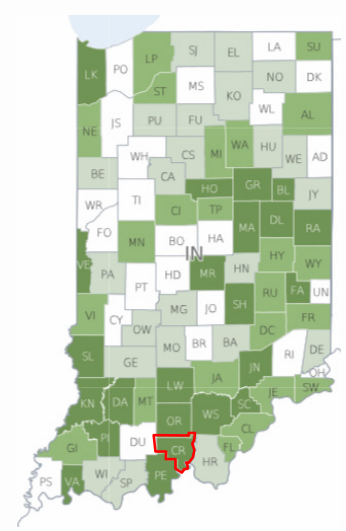
### MORTALITY

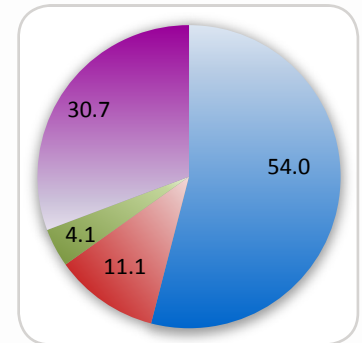
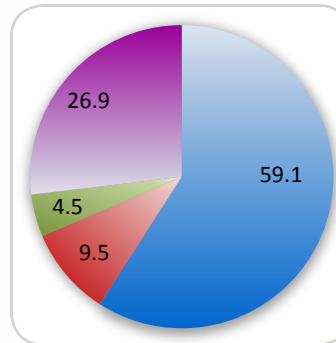
